## **Therapy Corner**

Welcome again to another edition of Therapy Corner. Since April is National Occupational Therapy Month, I want to talk about therapy from an Occupational Therapist's perspective.


Occupational therapy consists of Occupational Therapists and Occupational Therapy Assistants (COTA). Occupational Therapy Assistants work directly with an Occupational Therapist to provide rehabilitation for patients who suffer from various medical issues.

One of the ways Occupational Therapists improve safety for patients is through environmental modifications. You can improve your home by removing unnecessary clutter, such as throw rugs, to create a safe walking space between furniture. Another way to improve your home environment is through proper lighting. You can also improve your environment by placing non-slip rubber pads under couch and chair cushions. Furthermore, grab bars can be placed in the shower and next to your toilet to increase safety during these activities.

Additionally, a shower chair, non-slip shower mat, and non-slip stickers can reduce the risk of falls. If you have any other safety questions or would like more information on ways to reduce fall risk, please ask one of your staff therapists. If you feel that you have some of the issues mentioned above and would like therapy to assist, consult with your doctor about occupational therapy. Our staff Occupational Therapist is named Brooke and our COTA is named Claudia. Please take a moment to wish them a happy Occupational Therapy month!




