

## THERAPY CORNER


As December approaches and the cold weather arrives, I want to address something that affects a large portion of the population this time of year: flu. The CDC reports flu activity starts to increase in October and November and peaks between December and February; it sometimes even lasts into May. Some risk factors that place people at higher risk for flu are asthma, neurological conditions, chronic lung disease (COPD,

cystic fibrosis, etc.), diabetes, heart disease (congestive heart failure, coronary artery disease, and congenital heart disease), adults 65 years and older, people who are obese with a BMI of 40 or higher, people with a weakened immune system due to disease, and people who live in long term care.

## Peg Rochine






She also performs pharmaceutical research and
