


Valentine's Day Signs — February's Craft

THERAPY CORNER

March 12th through March 18th is Patient Safety Awareness Week, so this month I am addressing potential safety risks.

One of the areas that frequently increases fall risk is improper use of assistive devices. What is an assistive device? These are walkers, canes, or any other apparatus that assists you in mobility or daily living. These devices must be the correct height to fit each individual user. An improperly fitted device can be more of a hazard than a help.

A second hazard to be aware of are changes in walking surfaces. Often the areas where walking surfaces change from one type of surface to another will have a height difference which can be a tripping hazard. Always be aware of your environment and take extra precautions with these changes. Similarly, be mindful

of doorways, as the thresholds are typically raised and can be a tripping hazard.

Lastly, I do not recommend area rugs. These are a common fall risk as the edges can serve as a tripping hazard or can potentially slip from under your feet.

If you have questions about your living environment, or if you are having difficulty navigating some of the obstacles mentioned, contact the therapy department, and we will happily answer any questions or concerns you may have.

Remember, stay active and keep moving to stay healthy!




Ms. Latonya Montage


